**INTERNATIONAL BOER GOAT ASSOCIATION
RULES WILL PREVAIL.**

BEDDING

ALL BEDDING MUST BE PROVIDED BY EXHIBITOR. THIS MAY BE BROUGHT FROM HOME OR PURCHASED AT FAIR. NO BULK SAWDUST, TAN BARK OR SHAVINGS PERMITTED. ONLY BALED OR BAGGED BEDDING ALLOWED.

ENTRY DEADLINE: JULY 10

All entries and awards in this department will be subject to the General Rules and Regulations published in this premium list and also to the following rules:

1. Entries in this department must be filled out on the livestock form, giving the name, registration number, and date of birth of the animals to be exhibited. Entries must be accompanied by entry fee of \$5 per head. LATE ENTRIES: An entry fee of \$10 per head will be charged for all entries postmarked after July 10. Absolutely no entries will be accepted after July 25. Only animals registered in a recognized Association (International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. (Whitewright, TX), American Boer Goat Assn. (San Angelo, TX), Canadian Boer Goat Assn. (Alberta, Canada), The USBGA (Spicewood, TX)) may be shown in official International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. sanctioned shows. Only International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. registered animals may be awarded points. If animal is not International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. registered, owner has the option to register winning animals within five business days with International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. and still be eligible to be awarded points. If winning animal is not International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. registered within allotted time, points will not be awarded.

2. Substitutions will be allowed in the same class only and must have the same ownership as the original entry. Substitutions should be made at check-in. Group class entries will be made at check-in.
3. The base date for computing ages for entries shall be the date the animals are to be judged.
4. A registration certificate is required for all animals.
5. A stamped duplicate or faxed duplicate application showing the date received by the International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. office is required on all animals under six (6) months of age.
6. No copies of registration or stamped duplicate of official registration should be accepted by the show officials unless the animal is under six (6) months of age.
7. The documents specified above as the requirements for that age animal to be shown must be presented to the Show Secretary for verification before the judging begins.
8. Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration document. Persons showing animals whose registration certificates have signed transfers that have not been processed by the International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. office must show those animals as agent for the owner on International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. records.
9. All goats must have a legible tattoo or other means of permanent identification consistent with its registration certificate or the animal will be disqualified.

An exhibitor that is showing an animal with a microchip as permanent identification is required to provide a microchip reader for verification of animal identity.

10. If an animal is registered in the International Boer Goat Association, Inc., that registration number must be listed on the entry form.
11. Exhibitors bringing entries into Fairgrounds on August 18 must pay admission or present exhibitor's ticket. Exhibitor tickets may be purchased on your Entry Form.
12. All livestock should be brought through Gate 4 on Crittenden Drive.
13. All exhibitors are limited to winning two premiums and two ribbons in each class.
14. Animals entered will be received beginning at 8:00 a.m. on August 18 and must be in place by noon, August 18.

15. No guarantee can be made as to the safety of the exhibits but every precaution will be taken to safeguard the animals.
16. Only goats entered in the show will be permitted in the barn.
17. Any animal that has attained the “Platinum Champion” status or has received sufficient points to reach the “Platinum Champion” status is ineligible to show in International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. sanctioned or otherwise sponsored events. These animals are eligible to be displayed at any International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. events.
18. The International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. Judge’s Committee reserves the right to send Trainee or Apprentice Judges to serve under a Senior Judge at any Sanctioned Show for training and/or educational purposes.
19. It is the responsibility of the show secretary to have a copy of the International Boer Goat Association, Inc. Official Show Rules and Breed Standards available at all times in case any questions arise during the course of the show.
20. See General Rules for information on Health Regulations and Protest.

EXHIBITOR/JUDGE GUIDELINES

1. An exhibitor shall not knowingly show an animal that does not meet eligibility requirements.
2. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge from whom it was purchased or possession taken within 90 days of show.
3. An exhibitor shall not present an animal to be shown under a judge who is his/her immediate family or employer or employee.
4. Any judge being co-owner with another member/owner/exhibitor shall not be allowed to judge that member’s animals for a period of six (6) months after dissolving ownership. Should this happen, all points awarded by that judge will be forfeited.
5. Any judge having any sale with one or more members that enhances either party’s income, shall not be allowed to judge that person’s animals for a period of 30 days prior to said event or 30 days after the event. If this happens, all points awarded by the judge during that time period will be forfeited.
6. The exhibitor shall take caution when entering their animals in a show not to compromise the judge’s integrity.

7. If a complaint is filed or we have reason to believe that an animal has been given growth enhancing drugs, we reserve the right to test the animal in question. If the animal tests positive, the points awarded will be forfeited.
8. No exhibitor will talk with the judges unless they are spoken to first, while in the show ring.
9. The Show Secretary is responsible for accuracy of show results prior to sending in to International office. Judge is not responsible.

DIVISION OF SANCTIONS AND SELECTION OF GRAND & RESERVE CHAMPIONS

International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. shows may sanction any or all of the following:

Fullblood/Purebred Bucks

Fullblood/Purebred Does

Percentage Does (1/2, 3/4, & 7/8 Bloods)

All events sanctioned must be held if any of the breed are present.

Entries may not be added or withdrawn from class without permission from the ring steward after the class is in the ring and judging has started. The only possible exception is in the event that such animal was previously entered in the wrong class. The class shall not be reopened after Judge has begun announcing reasons for placement.

Junior Shows, Junior Division Classes and Championships (Does & Bucks)

1. Any animal that is under 12 months of age shall compete as a Junior.
2. Junior Grand Champion shall be selected from the first place blue ribbon winners of classes in the Junior division.
3. Junior Reserve Champion shall be selected after the Junior Grand Champion and shall be selected from the animals remaining in the Junior Champion class plus the animal that stood second to the Junior Grand Champion.

Yearling Division Classes and Championships (Does & Bucks)

1. Any animal that is 12 months to under 24 months of age shall compete as a Yearling.
2. The Yearling Grand Champion shall be selected from the blue ribbon winners of classes in the Yearling division.
3. The Yearling Reserve Champion shall be selected after the Yearling

Grand Champion and shall be selected from the animals remaining in the Yearling Champion class plus the animal that stood second to the Yearling Grand Champion.

Senior Shows, Senior Division Classes and Championships (Does & Bucks)

1. Any animal that is 24 months of age or older shall compete as a Senior. A buck must have offspring resulting from live coverage, a doe must have offspring resulting from natural birth. Any animals that do not meet these requirements are not eligible to show.
2. The Senior Grand Champion shall be selected from the first place blue ribbon winners of classes in the Senior division.
3. The Senior Reserve Champion shall be selected after the Senior Grand Champion and shall be selected from the animals remaining in the Senior Champion class plus the animal that stood second to the Senior Grand Champion.

Overall Shows, Junior, Yearling & Senior Divisions (Does & Bucks)

1. Overall Grand Champion shall be selected from the winners of the Grand Champion from each division.
2. Overall Reserve Champion shall be selected from the winners of the Grand and Reserve Champion from each division.

POINTS EARNED BY COMPETITION

Animals shall compete in the appropriate age group, according to the birth date recorded on the registration certificate. Animals will not be awarded points for wins in younger age classes than they are eligible to compete.

Animal must have legible tattoo before it enters the show ring to receive points. The tattoo must match the registration certificate. The registration number(s) shown on the certificate(s) must match the official class forms.

Tattoo not matching Registration Certificate, or tattoos that are missing or illegible, shall result in that animal being disqualified from the show. Registration papers should be verified by show officials against information provided by exhibitors upon check-in of the animals. The Judge must verify tattoos by using registration papers on animals that are awarded Grand and Reserve Champion.

Pair class entries are exempt from receiving additional points from their competition in the pair classes.

COMPLAINTS AND PENALTIES

All complaints filed by International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. members, fair officials or the exhibitors pertaining to the ethics and competency of a judge are to be referred to International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. Judges Committee and/or Ethics Committee in writing within one week of occurrence. A witness signature or corroborating statement is recommended.

All complaints pertaining to the actions and/or conduct of an exhibitor are to be addressed to the Ethics Committee and submitted in writing within one week of occurrence.

All complaints regarding judges are to be sent with a non refundable fee of \$35.00, to defray the expense of reviewing such complaint, to the International Boer Goat Assn., Inc. office.
