## RULES

**Entry Fee - \$8.00**

1. All entries must be made on official State Fair entry blanks for this department and postmarked by July 1. Entry fee must accompany entry form. Exhibitors in the Antiques Department have the option of making entries online. For more information see page 7. To enter online, go to [www.kystatefair.org](http://www.kystatefair.org). Online entries require a credit card. Complete information must be provided.
2. No organization or business may enter in the Antique Department.
3. For exhibitors 18 to 54 years of age as of August 1, an \$8.00 departmental entry fee is required. For senior citizens 55 years of age and over as of August 1, the fee is \$6.00 per department. Entries must be postmarked by July 1 or a late fee will be charged.

**LATE ENTRIES:** An entry fee of \$15 per department will be charged for **all** entries postmarked after July 1. Late entry forms must be received by July 10. No entries will be accepted after that date.

4. Exhibitors are limited to one item in each class. Unless otherwise specified, multiple items in a set are not permitted. A group of buttons is permitted in class 35 only, with a limit of 12 buttons.
5. After all entries are processed the State Fair will mail entry tags to exhibitor. The exhibitor should place these entry tags on proper articles. Each exhibitor should retain duplicate part of entry tag to identify and reclaim article at close of Fair.
6. Exhibitors living outside Louisville and vicinity may ship entries, postage prepaid, to the Antique Department, c/o Entry Dept., 937 Phillips Ln., Louisville, KY 40209. Packages must arrive by August 8.
7. **EXHIBITORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REMOVE ARTICLES FROM THIS DEPARTMENT UNTIL MONDAY,**

**AUGUST 31, AT 9:00 A.M. ANY ARTICLE NOT CLAIMED BY 7:00 P.M. ON MONDAY, AUGUST 31, WILL BE PROPERLY DISPOSED OF BY THE KENTUCKY STATE FAIR.**

8. All articles (outside Louisville and vicinity) not called for will be repacked and returned to the exhibitor at the exhibitor's expense and risk. The Kentucky State Fair assumes no responsibility for any item that may be damaged or lost. Parcels will be sent C.O.D. Exhibitors living in Louisville and vicinity must pick up their exhibits as they will not be mailed.
9. Professionals will be barred in this department. One who derives the major part of income from type of work being exhibited by him/her is considered a professional in this department.
10. An exhibitor winning first prize in a class one year is barred from exhibiting the same article in that class at any subsequent State Fair.
11. The Management will not be responsible for any article exhibited but due care and diligence will be given in the handling of articles and guards will be furnished to give reasonable protection to exhibits at all times.
12. The Fair will not act as a selling agency. No articles can be shown in this Department with a "For Sale" tag. Any sales made of articles exhibited in this department will be between the owner and the prospective purchaser.
13. All entries in this department will be displayed at the discretion of the management.
14. Honorable Mention Ribbons awarded at judge's discretion.
15. **To be considered antique, an article must be at least 50 years old. Article must be owned by exhibitor. Size of photographs in class 30 may not exceed 4" x 6" (including frame, if any) and size of photographs in classes 31 and 32 may not exceed 12" in height, length or width (including frame, if any). Other entries may not exceed 18" in height, length or width (including frame, if any). These size limitations do not apply to firearms, swords, fishing tackle, clothing, coverlets or quilts.**
