### RULES

**ENTRY DEADLINE: JULY 10**

**Entry Fee: \$2.00 per bird**

**AMERICAN DOVE ASSOCIATION SANCTIONED MEET**

**Sale Coops:** \$5 each (Must accompany entry blank). Any exhibitor who wants to sell or trade birds must exhibit at least 10 birds to be given the opportunity of renting a coop of 4 holes. (Limit of two coops per exhibitor) A maximum of 12 birds will be allowed in a 4-hole coop at any one time. If birds are sold, and the buyer wishes to take them with him, the exhibitor must get a release slip from the superintendent or assistant superintendent. These coops are to be supervised at all times by the superintendent, assistant superintendent, or someone designated by them in their absence.

1. Entries must be made on official State Fair entry forms or by online entry. Entry forms must be postmarked by July 10. For more information on online entries, see page 7. To enter online, go to [www.kystatefair.org](http://www.kystatefair.org). Online entries require a credit card for payment of fees. Complete information is required when making online entries. Exhibitor admission tickets may be purchased at time entry is made. Youth exhibitors (age 18 or younger) should indicate their date of birth on the entry.
2. All varieties competing in the young bird classes must wear 2012 seamless club bands of the correct size, one numbered band per bird. Exhibitors must write band numbers on coop cards when cooping entries.
3. Any specimens showing symptoms of disease or parasites when received or during the exhibition will be removed from the showroom.
4. The management will use every precaution in this department but will not be responsible for loss or accident. Competent attendants will be assigned to handle the cooping, feeding and care of all specimens. No one will be allowed to handle stock except by permission of the superintendent or owner.

5. **Reception of Birds:** Pigeon Department (located in Pavilion) will be open for reception of entries on Wednesday, August 15 at 10:00 a.m. All stock must be in coops by 10:00 a.m. Thursday, August 16. No exceptions.
6. **Schedule of Judging:** Judging will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 16 and run consecutively as listed in catalog.
7. **All exhibitors are limited to winning three premiums and three ribbons in each class. Each bird must be owned by the exhibitor.**
8. All exhibitors present during judging are required to handle their own birds or designate someone to do so. Otherwise, birds will be judged in coops.
9. See General Rules for protests and other information.
10. Exhibitors failing to comply with any of the general rules or rules applying to their department will forfeit all premiums won.

**Birds may be taken home on Sunday, August 19, after 5:00 p.m.  
Exhibitors who remove birds before the official release time  
will forfeit all premiums.**
