RULES

All exhibitors: Please read the Textiles section carefully to avoid disqualification. There are changes in the rules and new categories.

1. See General Rules on pages 194-196.
2. Exhibitors are limited to one entry in each class.
3. **Unless otherwise specified, any item entered in Textiles must be: a) Handmade; b) The work of the person in whose name it is entered; c) Finished within the last three (3) years. Exhibitors must certify the above by signing the space provided on the entry form.**
4. Group quilts must be entered in classes 33-37. Group quilts are not permitted in any other class.
5. We understand that many quilts are now made by two people: one person may piece the quilt and another person actually quilts the quilt. Such items must be entered in classes 33-37. Also, we accept items in this department with the understanding that the work has been done by the entrant, who agrees to be governed by Fair rules and regulations.
6. The exhibitor must place entry tags on proper article in lower right hand corner of article.
7. **EXHIBITORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REMOVE ARTICLES FROM THIS DEPARTMENT UNTIL MONDAY, AUGUST 29 AT 9:00 A.M. ANY ARTICLE NOT CLAIMED BY 7:00 P.M. ON MONDAY, AUGUST 29, WILL BE PROPERLY DISPOSED OF BY THE KENTUCKY STATE FAIR.**
8. **All exhibits should be clean. Judges may penalize items which are not clean. Only items entered in a class in the Textiles Department will be accepted and displayed.**
9. An exhibitor winning first prize in a class one year is barred from exhibiting the same article in that class at any subsequent State Fair.
10. **Any article not up to standard in the class in which it is exhibited can be ruled out by the judge.**
11. If an item is disqualified in a class, it is not eligible for any other award.
12. If there is more than one article in any exhibit (such as towels, table

mats, etc.) they should be fastened together securely.

13. The Fair will not act as a selling agency. No articles can be shown in this Department with a "For Sale" tag. Any sales must be between the owner and the prospective purchaser.
14. **No pictures accepted unless properly framed and fixed for hanging with screw eyes and wire.**
15. **Only Textile Dept. official workers will be permitted in area during judging. The Textile Department would welcome your help on judging day if you do not have anything entered in the Textile Department. If you do have an entry, please help on another day during the fair.**

NOTE: SWEEPSTAKES and SPECIAL AWARDS will be given as listed. However, after receiving a sweepstakes or special award, three (3) fairs must pass (exclusive of winning year) before you are eligible for same sweepstakes or special award. No awards are exchangeable.

To determine sweepstakes winners, the following point system will be used: 15 points for blue ribbon; 10 points for red ribbon; 5 points for white ribbon and 3 points for pink ribbon.

(Point ties will be broken by counting the number of blue ribbons. Exhibitor with most blue ribbons is determined the winner. If blue ribbons are equal, then red ribbons will be counted. If red ribbons are equal, then white ribbons will be counted. Only if white ribbons are also equal will duplicate prizes be awarded. If a cash prize is offered by a sponsor, the amount will be divided equally between the winners.)

QUILTS

1. All quilts must have been completed within the last three years and must be clean and in good condition.

2. Quilts must have a sleeve (rod pocket) on the top back of the quilt large enough to accommodate a 4" rod. Both the top and bottom of the sleeve must be sewn on. Do not use pins. See diagram below:



Fold sides and sew.



Sew lengthwise, wrong sides together. Press Seam open.

8 1/2" x width of quilt, hem short sides.

Sew long sides with 1/4" seam.



After sewing to quilt, sleeve will pooch out to allow space for rod.

Hand sew to back-top of quilt.

3. Quilts without the proper rod pocket (no tabs) will not be judged or displayed.
4. If necessary, the quilt bottom will be pinned up to prevent it from touching the floor. The management will not be responsible for any articles exhibited, but due care and diligence will be given in the handling of articles.
5. Please read the classes carefully and enter the quilt in the correct class for size, intended use and techniques employed.
6. The perimeter of a quilt is the measurement around all four sides.
7. A quilt may be disqualified if it is entered into the incorrect class.
8. Judging standards are workmanship, general appearance, harmony of color and materials.
9. An original design is a creation produced by individual thought without replicating the works of others.

OPEN TECHNIQUE QUILT - CLASS 12

12. Must be three layers, and hand, machine or hand and machine quilted. No tied quilts will be accepted. Minimum of 24" on any one side, maximum of 108" on any side. NO quilts made from kits will be accepted. The quilt must be an original design, although traditional elements may be incorporated into the design. The quilt may be embellished with beading, embroidery, painting or any other technique that adds to the design. May NOT be framed with wood or metal, etc.
**In order to promote the contemporary art quilter, the Kentucky Heritage Quilt Society is sponsoring this category to encourage freedom in design and technique, as well as the materials used in the quilt. This category encourages innovative design by providing a place for non-traditional quilts.*

LAP OR WALL QUILTS - CLASS 13 - 20

Quilts must be less than 300" in perimeter. Note minimum size in each class. These quilts are intended for use as decorative wall hangings or lap quilts. All quilts in these classes are made by one person and can be quilted on a home machine or long arm but cannot be computer aided.

13. Small Quilt, minimum perimeter 140", hand pieced and/or appliquéd, **hand quilted.**

SPECIAL CATEGORIES - CLASS 21 - 32

Quilts in the following classes have specific requirements. **Read each category carefully for size, techniques used and/or special considerations.** All quilts in these classes are made by one person. Machine quilting cannot be computer aided unless otherwise noted.

21. New Quilt from Old - A quilt that has been made by the entrant from old blocks, old quilt pieces, an old quilt top or other unfinished old parts; or an old quilt that has been extensively repaired or refurbished by the entrant. The quilt may be pieced, appliquéd, embroidered, etc. or employ a combination of techniques. Must be quilted by the entrant, by hand or machine (in the case of a repaired quilt, the entrant must complete or repair some of the quilting). Minimum perimeter of 200" and not more than 400". An index card with the story of the origin of the quilt and the work done by the entrant must be attached to the quilt.
