## RULES

OPEN ENTRY DEADLINE: JULY 1  
FFA ENTRY DEADLINE: AUGUST 4  
4-H ENTRY DEADLINE: AUGUST 10

NOTE: SEE RULE NUMBER 7 FOR SCHEDULE

1. See West Hall Departments General Rules on pages 153-154.
2. Entries in 4-H & FFA classes must be made through the FFA advisor or 4-H Agent.
3. Only tobacco that has been entered by the deadlines specified above will be accepted at the Fair.
4. Entry tags to be placed on entries will be given to exhibitors upon arrival at Fair.
5. No owner of warehouse(s) will be allowed to exhibit in any class.
6. All exhibits should be brought to the Tobacco Department in the West Hall.

### Entries Accepted:

4-H Tobacco: Monday, August 13th - 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

FFA Tobacco: Tuesday, August 14th - 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

Open Tobacco: Monday, August 13th - 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Tuesday, August 14th - 9:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.

No tobacco will be accepted after the times listed. **JUDGING WILL BEGIN AT 12 NOON EDT, ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 15.**

7. Tobacco may not be removed before 6:00 p.m., August 26. Entries/exhibits may be picked up between 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m., Sunday, August 26. In addition, tobacco will be released Monday, August 27, from 9:00 a.m. to Noon.
8. 4-H and FFA exhibitors are eligible to compete in only one division of the youth show (4-H or FFA). They may compete in the Open Class, provided they have separate entries for that class. Open class entries must be made by July 2 on open class entry forms.

9. Entries in the 4-H and FFA classes are restricted to regularly enrolled members of these organizations.
10. **The Superintendent shall have the authority to reject any entry that in his opinion is unworthy of entry.**
11. **Entries infected with insects or disease, or exhibiting severe damage, shall be discarded at the discretion of the Superintendent.**
12. **Exhibitors may enter only one item per class.**
13. **Each exhibit of green tobacco consists of four (4) stalks per stick.**
14. All entries in the green classes should be wilted for a better presentation, but must still be in green stage. Green tobacco will be judged on uniformity, general appearance and quality. The Superintendent has the right to disqualify any stick entered in the green stick category that has cured beyond the green stage.
15. All growing tobacco plants should be potted in a waterproof plastic bag and placed in an attractive container before arrival at Fair.
16. Each exhibit of stripped Burley tobacco shall consist of two (2) hands, and each hand shall be made up of twenty (20) leaves or more. The first, second, and third place entries in all stripped divisions will remain at the State Fair.
17. Types 22-23 Dark Fired tobacco will be exhibited in the same class, but type 35 (one sucker) will be exhibited in a separate class.
18. Each exhibit of types 22 and 23 Dark Fired stripped tobacco shall consist of two (2) hands of eight (8) leaves each. Each exhibit of type 35 (one sucker) stripped tobacco shall consist of two (2) hands of fifteen (15) leaves each.
19. \$1,290 in premiums offered for 4-H will be awarded on the Danish system.

The following points system will be used in awarding of plaques:

1st place.....	10 points
2nd place.....	9 points
3rd place.....	8 points
4th place.....	7 points
5th place.....	6 points
6th place.....	5 points
7th place.....	4 points
8th place.....	3 points
9th place.....	2 points
10th place.....	1 point

(In event of tie, winner shall be decided by exhibitor winning most blue ribbons.)

4-H and FFA Best Overall Exhibitor - exhibitor in each youth organization with highest total points will receive an engraved plaque. To be eligible, exhibitor must enter three of the following classes:

Burley - Stripped	Dark Stripped
Burley - Best Crop	Green Stick - Dark
Green Stick Burley	Dark-Best Crop
Potted Burley	Potted Dark

Kentucky Department of Agriculture.

Entries shall be on an individual basis and must be produced by the individual making entry. Only one entry per individual is permitted and an entry shall consist of four grades: Flying, Lug, Leaf and Tip. Each grade shall consist of two hands of 20 leaves each and samples entered in Classes 1 through 12 shall not be considered for this class.
