RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY BLANKS

Entry Forms - The entry forms must contain all information requested, including complete mailing address, social security number and signature. Your entry form must be neat and correct. Entries should be mailed to Kentucky State Fair, Morgan Horse Show, P.O. Box 37130, Louisville, KY 40233. Additional entry blanks may be obtained by writing to the above address or by calling (502) 367-5300, FAX (502) 367-5305. Catalogs and entry forms will also be on our web site www.kyfairexpo.org.

- a. No entries will be accepted by telephone, but completed entry form may be faxed using credit card payment (Visa, MasterCard, Discover or American Express).

DO NOT duplicate entry by faxing and mailing.

- b. Full payment of entry fees, stall fees and drug fees required or entries will not be accepted.

ENTRY BLANK MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY!

PLEASE PRINT ON THE ENTRY BLANK!

Exhibitors should carefully read the conditions stated on each entry blank as these will be strictly enforced.

The word "ENTRY" will not be accepted. Each entry blank must contain the name and full description of each horse and the class in which it is entered clearly enumerated.

- a. Entries in all horsemanship classes must be made in the name of the individual who will ride. Do not make these entries in stable names or the names of parents.
- b. Every owner, trainer, rider/driver/handler/vaulter and longuer must sign the entry blank which must be accompanied by check covering all fees and charges. Both lines must be signed.
- c. The Make Check Payable To listed on the bottom of the entry blank will be the one all correspondence will be sent to and also the name on the premium check.
- d. Please make sure to fill out all spaces, name, trainer, owner's address, phone numbers and complete address where specified. **ONE CHECK PER ENTRY BLANK ONLY AND IT SHALL EQUAL THE AMOUNT OWED ON THE ENTRY BLANK.**

COPIES OF REGISTRATION PAPERS (both front and back) AND YOUR MEMBERSHIP CARD MUST BE SENT IN WITH YOUR ENTRY BLANK. (BRING ORIGINALS TO THE SHOW.)

Post entries: Post entries will be accepted at double fee (entry fee and office charge) up until one (1) hour before the session.

Electronic Registration

Registration Form
 - a. Right click on the Registration Form link above and choose "Save as..." or "Save Target as..." and save it on your desktop.
 - b. Open the file and scroll down to the bottom where there are tabs. Please choose the red colored tab named "Entry Sheet". The other tab is general instructions for each section.
 - c. Fill in the green shaded areas in the sections that apply to you, making certain to save the sheet occasionally to prevent losing information.
2. When you have completed the form:
 - a. Go to "File" and select "Save" to save all entry information.
 - b. Sign into your email account of choice.

EXHIBITORS

Any exhibitor, rider, or driver who refuses to obey the request of the Judge, Ringmaster or Manager automatically becomes debarred from further competition and forfeits all previous winnings, together with entry fees and other charges. At the discretion of the Manager, the offending individual and his entire exhibit may be removed from the grounds.

The right is reserved to combine classes, or to cancel any class in which a sufficient number of entries is not received. The right is also reserved to rearrange classes in the schedule. However, the exhibitor making entries in such classes will be notified at least 12 hours in advance of the scheduled time of the class.

Horses must be ready ten minutes before the class in which they are entered is called. Warning as to the progress of the preceding class will be given over the loud speakers in the Stable Area. The Horse Show will not be responsible for an Exhibitor's failure to hear the call.

Protests: All protests must be filed as set forth in USEF GR603, Anyone desiring to speak to a Judge must make an appointment with the Show Steward who will arrange a meeting.

Hoof length and shoe type and weight to be governed by USEF GR304.

No substitution of horses will be permitted. See USEF GR1506

AMATEUR STATUS

All riders in AOTR classes must have an Amateur Card if over the age of 18. Riders must present this card or make application for one before entering the ring. Applications for amateur cards will be available in the Show Office. Amateur/Owner to Ride may also include an amateur member of the owner's family. Combined ownership is not permitted in AOTR and JOTR classes unless all owners are members of the same family.

ENTRY FEES

Entry fee in each class is listed in the prize list. The Kentucky State Fair reserves the right of declining to accept any entry or entries and to return any and all entrance fees. Also to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any owner or stable employee or horse from the ring or from the grounds without liability of any kind.

There will be NO charging of entries or other fees. If you post enter you must pay at that time. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks. We reserve the right to return checks and request cash for fees.

DOGS

Dogs are permitted at the Show only if they are confined to the stable and tack room area and they must be kept tied or on a leash. No dogs allowed in the Coliseum or Horse Show office.

JUDGING

During the time of the judging no person will be allowed in the Ring, except the Ring Attendants, Judge of the Class then in the Ring, and when necessary, the Handler in charge of the horses being judged.

If for any reason one of the judges has to be withdrawn from judging a class due to circumstances unforeseen in advance by the Horse Show Management, another judge will be substituted.

No attendant or groom will be allowed in the horse show arena unless he is wearing suitable attire.

Decisions of the Judge or Judges will be final.

VETERINARIAN

The Kentucky State Fair has named Dr. John Moran and Associates of Flemingsburg, KY to be the official veterinarians who will be in attendance and will inspect such horses as may be designated by the judge or judges or the Horse Show Manager and their decision will be FINAL. One official veterinarian will be in attendance for each show to pass on any question pertaining to the soundness of any horse before being excused from the class. His decision will be final without recourse of any nature. The number for Dr. Moran will be posted in the Horse Show Office; contact the Horse Show Office at 367-5300.

STALLS

EXHIBITORS - Upon arrival, **report to the Stall Trailer by Barn O (watch for signs)**, for stall placements. Horses will not be stabled until after 10:00 a.m., Sunday, August 16, and must be out by 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, August 19.

Stalls in the horse barns will be limited exclusively to horses entered and to be shown in the 2009 Kentucky State Fair Horse Shows. This rule is necessary owing to limited number of available stalls. All stalls have doors.

ALL HORSES ENTERED MUST PAY THE \$40.00 STALL FEE.

NO FIRST BEDDING.

PREMIUM CHECKS

Checks will be mailed within 30 days.

MISCELLANEOUS

Rooms are available at the Crowne Plaza, (502) 367-2251.

All horses will be under the care and supervision of their owners. The Fair Management will not be responsible for injury to horses or attendants.

You may pick up your back numbers in the Horse Show Office beginning on Sunday, August 16, 2009, 2:00 P.M.

There will be ample parking space on the fairgrounds for trailers and vehicles.

or forfeit the prize money from the performance classes.

Kentucky County Fair Championship Classes: Stallion, Mare or Gelding, any age. To be eligible the entry must have qualified by showing in the same section of the Morgan division at three (3) member shows of the Kentucky Association of Fairs and Horse Shows. Qualifying period includes - day following the 2008 Kentucky State Fair Morgan Horse Show until the day beginning the 2009 Kentucky State Fair Morgan Horse Show. Owner of the horse must be a paid 2009 KAFHS member. A list of shows and horses shown, submitted by the KAFHS Executive Secretary will be available in the Horse Show Office. Likewise, a list of members paid will be available. If you are not a 2009 paid member, forms to join will be available in the Horse Show Office. Individual membership fee is \$30.00.

MORGAN SECTION

General Qualifications - Eligibility (MO101)

1. Horses shown in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association, or the British Morgan Horse Society and must be entered under their full registered name or if under one year of age be eligible for registration.
2. Canadian horses born before January 1, 1985 must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc. or have Canadian Morgan Horse Club registration papers showing an American registration number. Canadian horses born after January 1, 1985, can be shown with Canadian registration papers as long as the papers do not state "not eligible for U.S. reciprocity."

MORGAN HALTER DIVISION

IN HAND - Horses shall enter the ring and be lined up at the direction of the judge. Entries are to be judged individually, standing then at a walk and trot on the line and must be serviceably sound. Horses must stand with front legs perpendicular to the ground. Rear legs may be placed slightly back but the horse must also be judged at some time in the class not stretched. Emphasis is placed on type and conformation with consideration given to horse's ability to move correctly on the lead. Unnatural tail carriage should be penalized. See MO114.2 and MO114.3. Curb bits are prohibited for weanlings and yearlings in In Hand classes. Only the first and second place winners will be eligible to show in the Halter Championship Classes.
